I reviewed every CIMT I have ever ordered over the weekend to try to find patterns and increase my learning. I have questions regarding the following studies. Unless otherwise noted, my question for each is, "Is this a real plaque since it is only in one location?".

Billy Cobb - Plaque in one location (left femoral). No inflammation. Is this a real plaque? If so, would you order both carotid and femoral to monitor this patient? 12/6/2016 he had the following surgery which I thought may affect the femoral study - 1) Left hip arthroscopy with focal acetabular rim trimming and 5 anchor labral repair. 2) Left hip acetabular chondroplasty and microfracture. 3) Left hip femoral head-neck junction osteochondroplasty. 4) Left hip capsular synovectomy, synovectomy of fovea, and capsular closure upon conclusion of case.
