Hello Angela,

I am concerned that one plaque measurement may actually be artery wall visualized tangentially, and not plaque.

Please ask Todd whether he thinks this needs to be checked. I hope he can tell from his first glance at the image, rather than a whole recheck.

Patient has a far below average mean and max, other than one measurement of the LICA. If I am correct that the lower right hand image shows the lesion, I notice that the artery shape is very tortuous at that point, and the echogenic shapes within the artery are not typical of plaque, I believe. They are reminiscent of artery wall seen tangentially, though I have seen very few of those. I may be totally off in these impressions, of course.
